foreground	The part of a view that is nearest to the observer	A vanishing point is the point at which receding parallel lines viewed in perspective appear to converge
line	lines can be vertical, horizontal, diagonal, or curved. They can be any width or texture	
urban	in, relating to, or characteristics of a town or city	
parallel	side by side and having the same distance continuously between them	
three dimensional	solid rather than flat, because it can be measured in three directions	Key knowledge – Tone and Hue
converge	tend to meet at a point	Tone is the light and dark values used to render a realistic birt Tints Tones (rgrey) Shades
aerial perspective	the technique of representing more distant objects as fainter and more blue	
receding	go or move back or further away from a previous position
