## Pop Up Swimming Pool Programme – Swim:ED

Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

We are delighted to let you know that your child will be taking part in a pop-up pool swimming programme called Swim:ED. Attached to this letter is an information leaflet from ActiveMe 360 who will be bringing their pool to Mason Moor Primary School providing your child with swimming lessons on our school site.

The Pop-Up Pool lessons will begin on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2023 and run through until 15<sup>th</sup> December 2023. Before your child begins the swim programme, ActiveMe 360 need some information on your child's ability and swimming experience. You have been emailed the letter from ActiveMe 360 which has a link on it for you to click on and provide the information requested so that children can be grouped accordingly. Children swim for up to 45 minutes a day and are taught by an ActiveMe 360 CIC fully qualified swimming teacher who will deliver the lesson supported by a lifeguard.

### What to wear for swimming

- Girls to wear a one-piece swimming costume
- Boys to wear swimming trunks or swimming shorts above the knee



Yours faithfully

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- Children can wear rash vests and leggings for modesty/cultural reasons if they wish to do so
- Towel to dry off after the swimming lesson
- Goggles if you have some but they can be provided by ActiveMe 360 if you don't have any
- A swim bag or plastic bag to store their wet kit and towel in after swimming
- A hair band if necessary, since long hair must be tied back
- No jewellery is to be worn in the pool including earrings, bracelets, waterproof
  watches etc. If your child has pierced ears, they must be able to take their earrings out
  to swim. If they cannot, school will assist with covering with tape before swimming.
  We advise that if your child does have pierced ears and can take them out, to not wear
  earrings to school on the day that they are swimming
- Please ensure that your child brings their kit to school with them Monday to Friday on their specified swimming weeks (dates provided in the swim timetable above). We recommend that children wear their swimming costume/trunks under their uniform when they dress for school on the days they are swimming to aid changing to swim before their session
