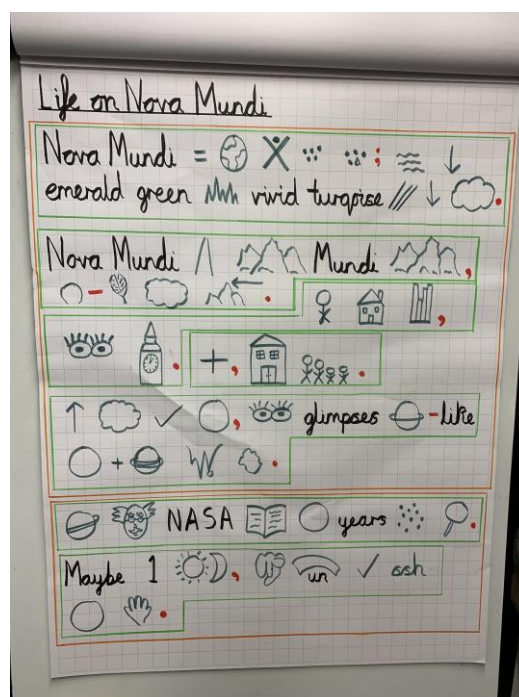
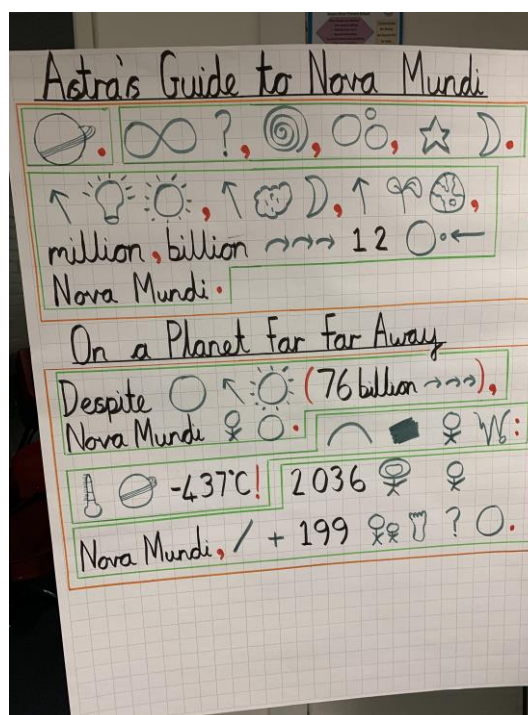
CLASS IN FOCUS – 5 / 6 Ainslie
