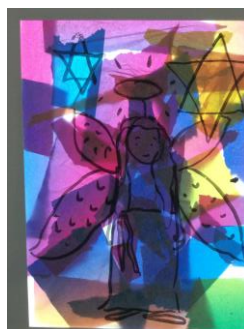
The children retold the nativity story through drama which they thoroughly enjoyed, particularly seeing their friends in costume!
