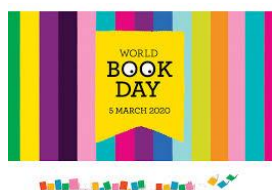

Year 1 are now being introduced to the topic, 'Superheroes'. This week we had our hook session linking to the character Supertato.



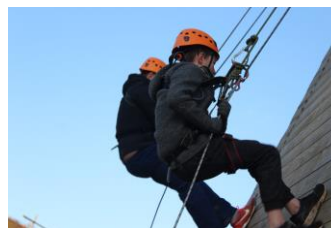
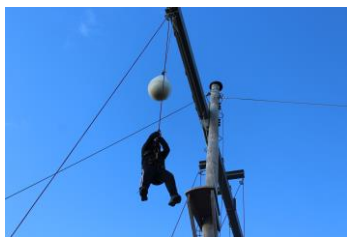
