We had a wonderful day yesterday in school for World Book Day. It was great to see so many children and adults dressed up as characters from books, comics and films.

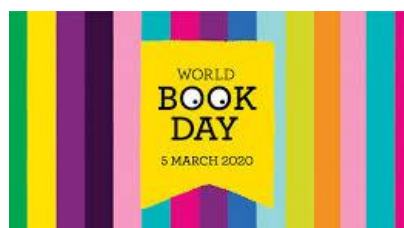


Congratulations to the winners from each class who each received an easter egg as a prize. All of the children throughout the school were also given a small prize in their class.

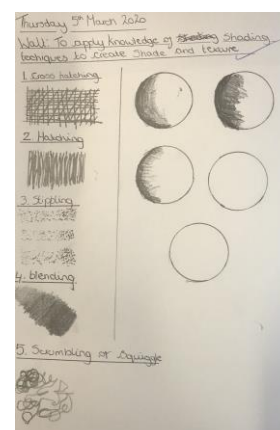

CLASS IN FOCUS – Year 5/6 Christiansen
