

Vocabulary	Meaning	Key knowledge – The Last Supper
symbol	something that represents or stands for something else	Jesus celebrated Passover (a Jewish festival) with his disciples. It was called The Last Supper because it was the last meal Jesus would eat before he died. Jesus and his disciples ate bread and wine. Jesus said the bread was his body and wine was his blood. While they were eating, Jesus said that one of his disciples (Judas) would betray him. During the meal, Jesus washed the disciples' feet. The disciples didn't want Jesus to wash their feet because it was a lowly task that would normally have been performed by a servant. Jesus washed his disciples' feet to show them the importance of selfless service. It showed how he was going to be a servant for all when he was crucified.
Eucharist (Mass or Holy Communion)	a symbolic ritual Christians perform to remember Jesus's sacrifice on the Cross. Small amounts of bread and wine are consumed to symbolise Jesus' body (bread) and his blood (wine)	
the Last Supper	Jesus' final meal with his disciples, where they at bread and wine. Jesus washed their feet.	
Maundy Thursday	the day when the Last Supper occurred, remembered by Christians through the Eucharist ritual
