


Knowledge Organiser: SPRING 2

Vocabulary	Meaning
precious	of great value, not to be wasted or treated carelessly
Christians	a person who follows the teachings of God through the Christian faith
baptism	a Christian ritual of sprinkling water on a person's forehead or immersing them in water
River Jordan	a river in the Middle East. It is important to Christians, Jews and Muslims
Jesus	God's son on Earth
Hindus	a person who follows the teaching of the Hindu faith
River Ganges	a river in India. It is important to Hindus

Key knowledge - John the Baptist and Shiva

John the Baptist dipped Jesus in the River Jordan, It was like a bath, but very special. It showed everyone that Jesus was starting something

important. God was very happy, and a dove even flew down to say so.



Shiva, a powerful god, held the Ganges River in his hair. When Earth needed water, he let it flow, creating the holy Ganges. People

believe bathing in it washes away sins. The river is a lifeline. bringing water and spiritual purity to millions in India.
