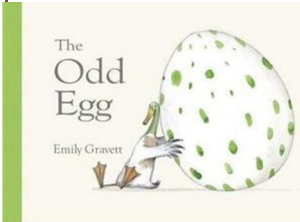
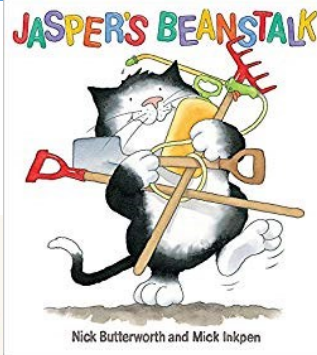


Spring has sprung!
