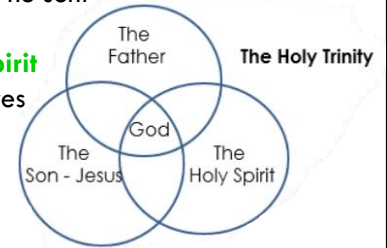




Vocabulary	Meaning
Kingdom	a country, state or territory ruled by a king or queen for Christians it is the spiritual reign or authority of God
Pentecost	the day when the Holy Spirit was given to Christians
The Holy Trinity	the three persons of the Christian Godhead; Father, Son and Holy Spirit
The Father	as the protector, the creator of everything and Lord over the universe
The Son	the incarnation of God as Jesus, the son of Mary
Holy Spirit	the power of God in our daily lives
guide	someone who shows the way
comforter	looks after in times of need
Church	a place of worship for those of the Christian faith

### Key knowledge – When Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost?

- **Christians** believe **Jesus** is still alive and rules in their heads by the **Holy Spirit**
- **Christians** believe Jesus' life shows that **God is King in heaven** and on Earth
- **Christians** believe after Jesus died he sent the **Holy Spirit** to his followers
- **Christians** believe that the **Holy Spirit** shows **Jesus' kingdom** by living lives reflecting love
- **Christians** celebrate **Pentecost** as the beginning of the **Church**
