Pentecost	the day when the Holy Spirit was given to Christians
The Holy Trinity	the three persons of the Christian Godhead; Father, Son and Holy Sprit
The Father	as the protector, the creator of everything and Lord over the universe
The Son	the incarnation of God as Jesus, the son of Mary
Holy Spirit	the power of God in our daily lives
guide	someone who shows the way
comforter	looks after in times of need
Church	a place of worship for those of the Christian faith


Assessment focus - Evaluate

- Christians celebrate Pentecost as the beginning of the Church


