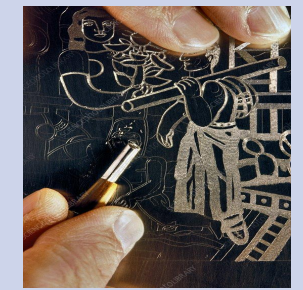

# Year 2 Art & Design: Patterns and Printmaking

Vocabulary	Meaning
pattern	a series of images created to make artwork
motif	starting image of a pattern that is repeated
regular motif	when the same image is repeated to create a pattern
irregular motif	when different repeated images are used to create a pattern
block repeat	where the motif is repeated
reflection	where the motif is reflected
rotation	where the motif is rotated around a point
half-drop	where the motif is dropped to a lower level so it is not in line with the original
roller	a tool used to flatten or apply something with
carving	cut to produce a picture
stamp	a hand-held device for inking and printing a message or picture onto a surface
incising	mark or decorate an object or surface with a cut or cuts
styrofoam	a material that can be carved
stylus	a writing implement

### Key knowledge – Intaglio printing

Intaglio printing is the opposite of relief printing, you **incise** an image into a material to create a print by using a **stylus**. You can use **styrofoam** for this.



### Key knowledge – Relief printing

A printing technique where the areas on a block are raised or sticking out and you then use it to **stamp** onto paper and make a **block repeat pattern** you can use **rotation** in this.



### Key knowledge – Monoprinting

A one off print technique in which a unique image a **irregular motif**, produced on a flat surface is transferred to paper.
