Vocabulary	Meaning
sketch	a drawing of something, created using pencil
narrative	a spoken or written account of connect events; a story
pressure	how hard or light something is pressed
shading	the darkening or colouring of an illustration or diagram with parallel lines or a block of colour
pattern	a repeated design
order	the arrangement of things according to a pattern
rule	an instruction that is followed
repeating	occur again in the same way or form
silhouette	the dark shape or outline of someone or something
negative space	space around an object
positive space	the shape of the object
materials	things needed for an activity
detail	to include lots of information
colour	the colour something such as red, blue, orange
symbol	a sign or object that represents something
shape	a geometric figure such as a square or triangle
line	a long, narrow mark or band
design	a decorative pattern
