






Vocabulary	Meaning
architecture	the design or style of a building
architect	a person who designs buildings
building	a place that is built that has a roof and windows
shape	the outline of an object
pattern	a repeated design
lightly	with little weight or force
sketch	a drawing or painting that was done in a hurry or without the detail
cityscape	the appearance of a city or urban area; a city landscape
skyline	the outline of natural or man-made structures against the sky
collage	a type of artwork in which different kinds of material are glued onto a surface to make a picture
materials	anything used for building or making something else
skyscraper	a very tall building
iconic	a person or thing that is an object of great respect and admiration
detail	decorative feature of a building or work of art
combine	join together
dome	a rounded vault forming the roof of a building or structure
design	plan or drawing produced to show the look or workings of a building

Key knowledge – Shape

2D – shape has only two measurements, such as length and height



3D – solid shapes that have three dimensions – length, width and height
