




Vocabulary	Meaning
Shabbat	the seventh day of the Jewish week, Saturday, is a special day used for prayers and rest.
Synagogue	the Jewish place of worship for followers of the Jewish faith.
Hebrew	ancient language spoken in Israel.
Torah	the Torah scroll is the Jewish Holy text. It is the first 5 books of 24 books in the Hebrew bible.
Star of David	A common symbol of Judaism and Jewish identity.
kosher	food that follows the Jewish laws set out in Leviticus.
God	the single god that Jewish people believe in.

Key knowledge – Shabbat

Shabbat is the **Sabbath day**, the holy day for **Jews**. They celebrate it by resting on the 7th day of the week (**Saturday**). On this day the Jews celebrate the **creation** of the world when **God** made the world in 6 days and rested on the 7th day. Some people call it '**the day of delight**' and have a special meal with candles and special food.



Two candles are lit by families to welcome or honor **Shabbat**.
