| Guru | a teacher and special person within the Sikhi faith |
| Guru Nanak | person who started the Sikhi faith |
| Guru Granth Sahib | was the last guru, this is also the name of their special book |
| sargun | the belief that God is everywhere and in everything |
| nirgun | the belief that God is above and beyond everything |
| Khanda | is the main symbol of Sikhism |
| shabads | sacred hymns in the Guru Granth Sahib |
| gurdwara | Sikhs place of worship, the word gurdwara means 'door to the Guru' |
| Gurbani | the word of the Gurus |
