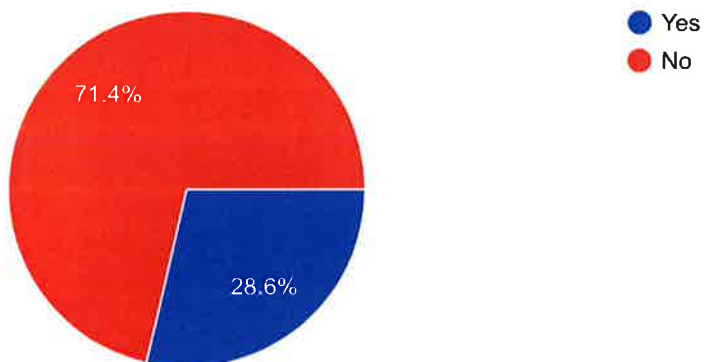

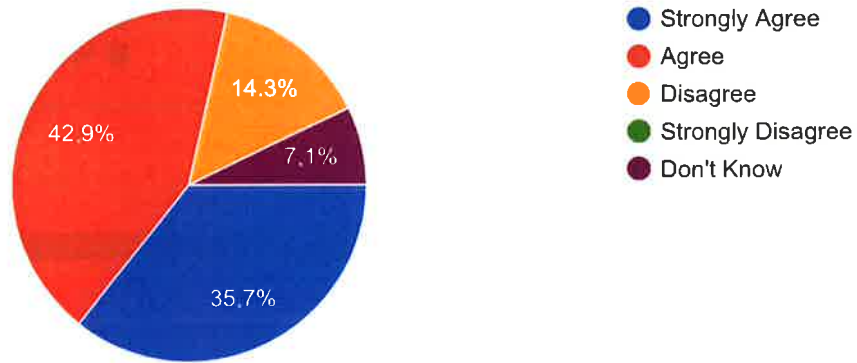

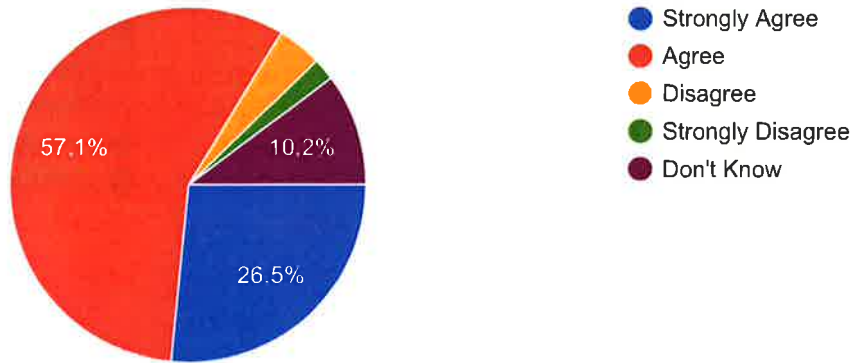

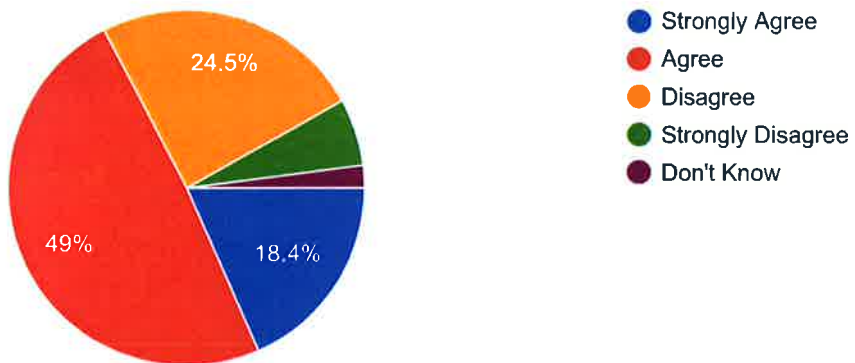

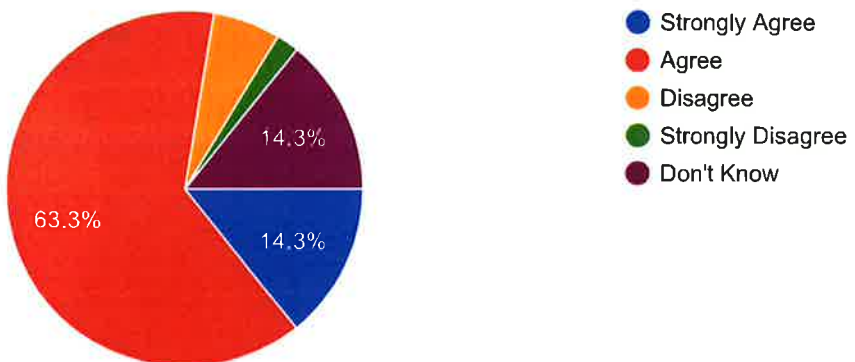

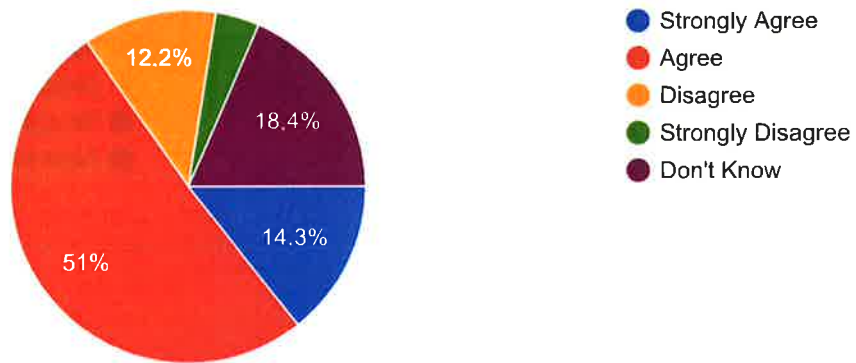

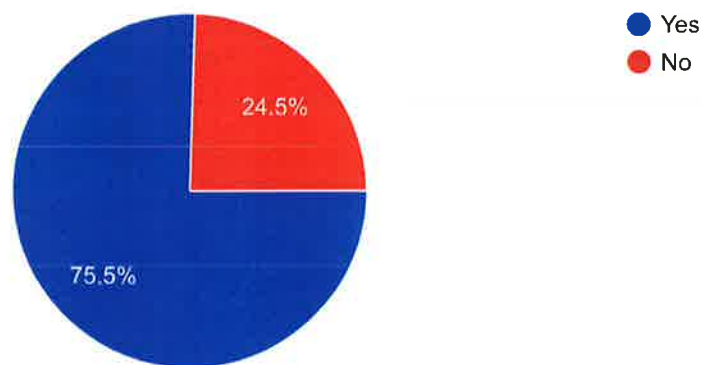

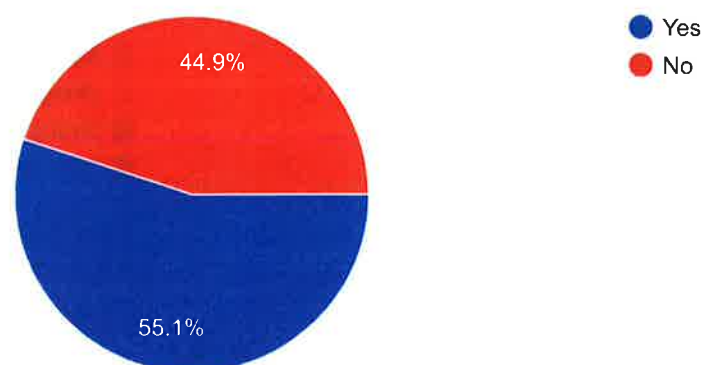

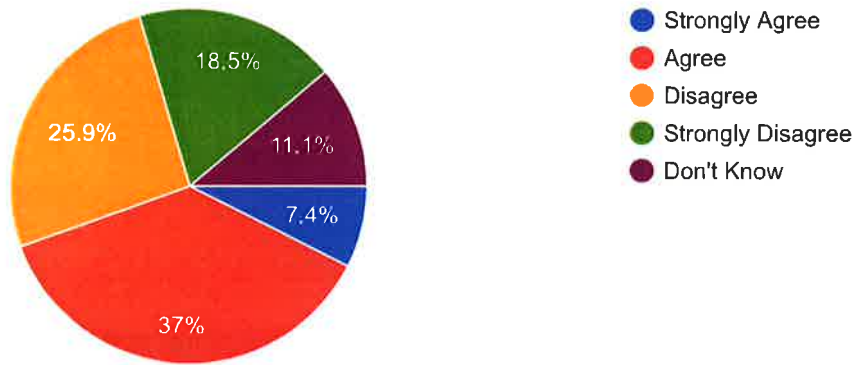

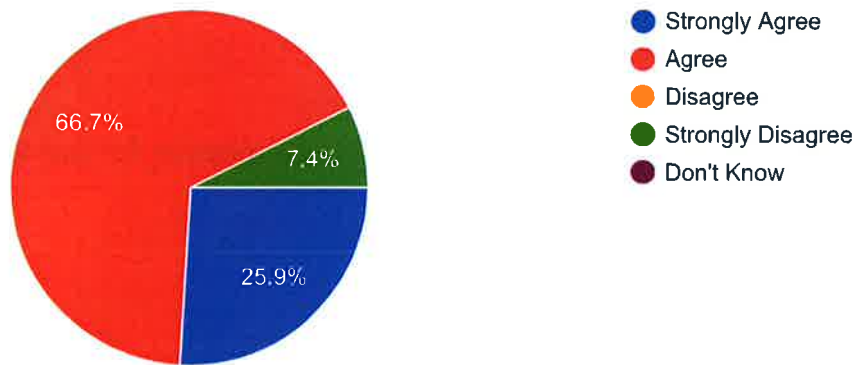

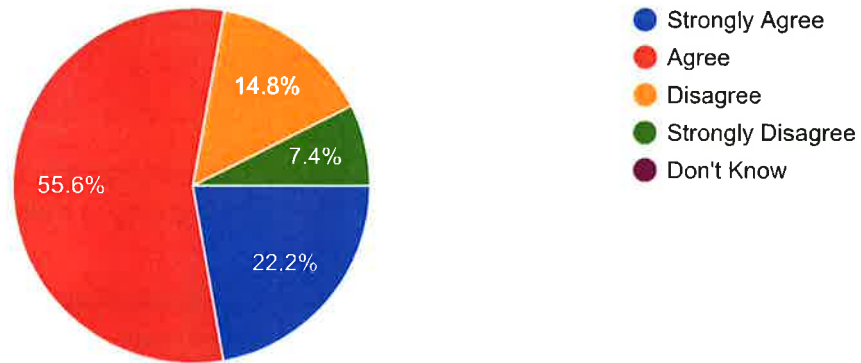
Have a period where the children can communicate with each other as this is very important part of learning.

They don't need to do nothing

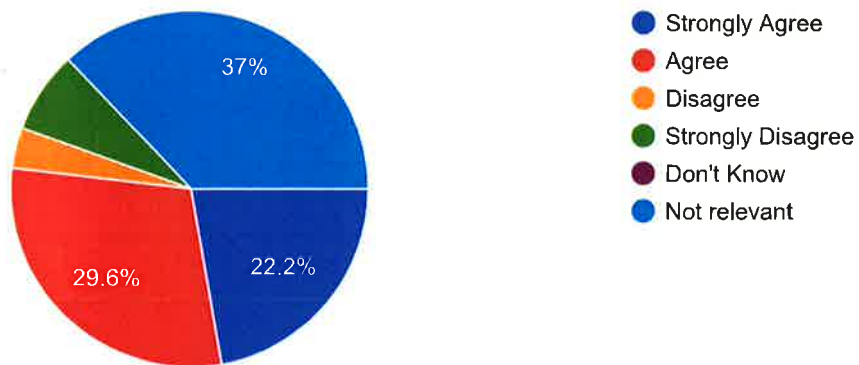

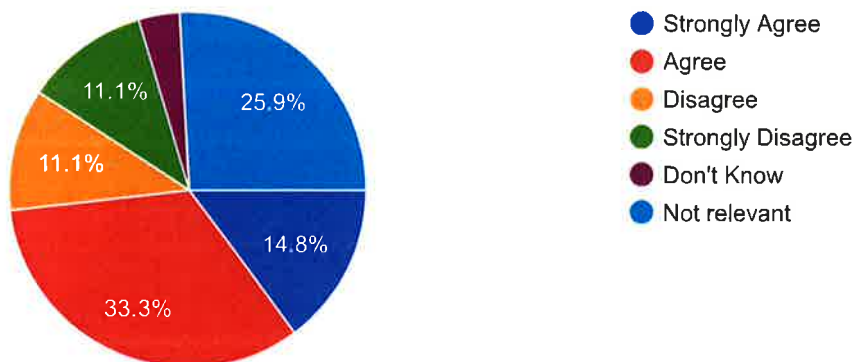
