Zacchaeus	a tax collector who wasn't liked by most of the people
tax	a sum of money that you have to pay
Bible	the Christian holy book that retells the story of Christianity
parable	a simple story use to teach a lesson, as told by Jesus in the Bible
disciples	followers of Jesus
Jesus' kindness	Christians believe Jesus could be kind to everyone because God was helping him. They believe He is God on Earth.
sinful	doing something that is wicked and immoral

### Key knowledge – The story of Zacchaeus (Luke 19:1-9)

Zacchaeus lived in Jerico and was hated because he was a tax collector. Jesus was passing through Jerico when a crowd came to worship him. Zacchaeus wanted to see Jesus but there were too many people so he climbed up a tree. Jesus saw him and asked to visit his house. This made people unhappy because they thought that God's son shouldn't visit a sinful tax collector.

Zacchaeus heard this and said to Jesus "Lord, I will give half of my riches to the poor." This made Jesus happy and he told the crowd what had happened. Zacchaeus was now a good, kind man who would share.
