avatar	incarnation/rebirth
Vishnu	Hindu god who protects the universe

Key knowledge –

Janmashtami (Krishna's birthday) is celebrated eight days after **Raksha Bandan**. Celebrations are over two days. The first day is **Krishan Ashtami** or **Gokul ashtami**. The second day is known as **Kaal ashtami** or more popularly **Janam ashtami**.
