what we are doing.



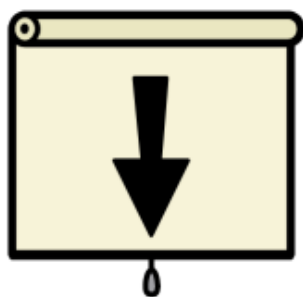
We will all go to the

close the windows,



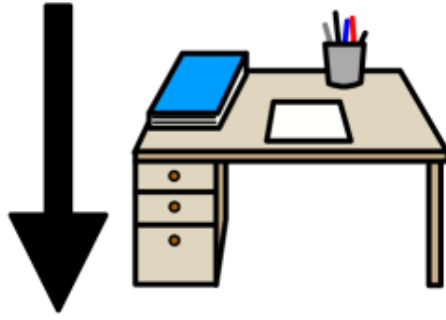
Staff will need to

turn off the lights.



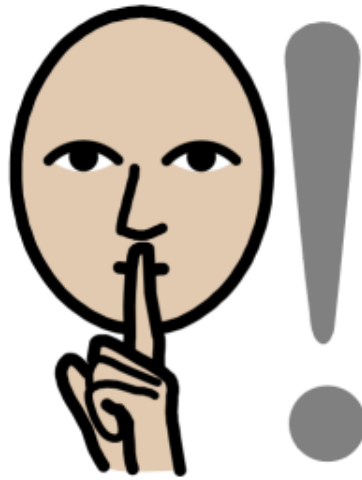
We will all get down
