Vocabulary	Meaning
Character	A printed or written letter or symbol
Thickness	A broad or deep part of a specified thing
Stroke	A short printed or written diagonal line
Watercolor	A painting method in which the paints are made of a water-based solution
Visual	Relating to seeing or sight
Effects	A particular impression
Static	Lacking in movement
Landscape	All the visible features of an area of land

Key knowledge - Art techniques

Baimiao - (Chinese for plain line) is a brush technique for drawing outlines of figures. This technique does not use any colour, shading or wash and is usually used for figure painting eg: humans and animals.

Calligraphy - Decorative handwriting or handwritten lettering.. Calligraphy uses a brush and ink to create symbols that act as a language. Calligraphy was the art form prized above all others in Ancient China.
