

Vocabulary	Meaning
Motion	The action or process of moving or being moved
Stop motion camera	A filming technique where an object is moved slightly and a picture is taken. This happens over and over until there are a sequence of frames
Frame rate	The speed at which each image in a television picture, film, or video sequence are displayed
Animation	The process of designing, drawing, making layouts and preparation of photographic sequences which are put together to make a video
Setting	The place or type of surroundings where something is positioned or where an event takes place.
Transition	The process changing from one scene to the next
Props	An object used on stage or screen by actors during a performance or screen production
Evaluate	To judge the value or worth of someone or something and how effective it is for its purpose
Comments	A written remark expressing an opinion or reaction.
Sequence	A particular order in which related things follow each other.

Key knowledge – character

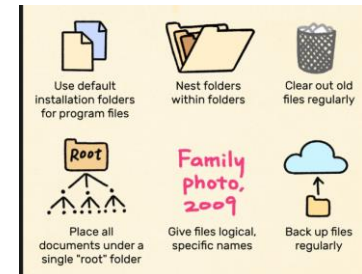


A Stikbot or figures will have a role to play in your animation, bringing it to life.
