equator	half way between the North and South pole
climate	the weather conditions prevailing in an area over a long period of time
peninsula	land surrounded by water or projecting into a body of water
Christ the redeemer	a statue of Jesus Christ in South America
squatter	a person who unlawfully occupies land or an unused building
slum	a squalid and overcrowded urban street inhabited by poor people
favela	a Brazillian shack or shanty town
high income	a person earning a large amount of money
population density	a measurement of how many people live in a particular area
landslide	a collapse of a mass of earth
trafficking	a deal or trade in something that is illegal
sanitation	the conditions relating to public health and sewage disposal
infrastructure	the basic physical organization structures – roads, building etc
regeneration	the clearing out and improvement of blighted areas
integrate	to combine one thing with another
