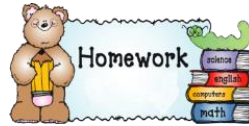

It is an expectation at Mason Moor that you complete homework.

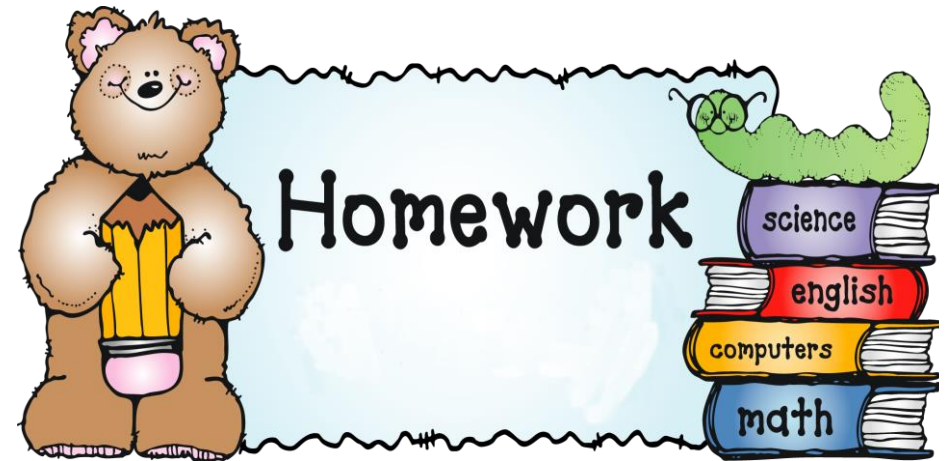

Extra homework

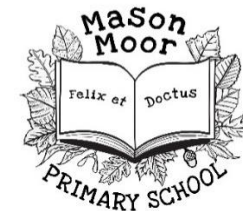
