## Extra homework

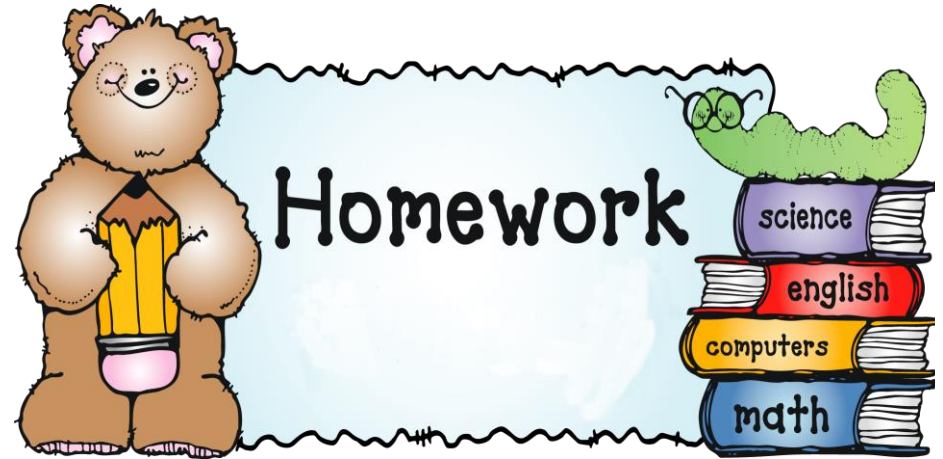
Don't forget to do your other homework too.

Make sure you read and / or share a book with someone and don't forget to fill in your reading stickers.



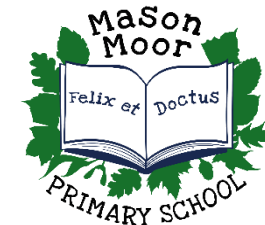
Practise your number bonds to 10 and 20.

## Homework activities



**Number Bonds**



All of these numbers pair together to make 10

Number bond equations (top row):

- $1 + 9 = 10$
- $2 + 8 = 10$
- $3 + 7 = 10$
- $4 + 6 = 10$
- $5 + 5 = 10$

Number bond equations (bottom row):

- $10 + 0 = 10$
- $9 + 1 = 10$
- $8 + 2 = 10$
- $7 + 3 = 10$
- $6 + 4 = 10$
