



Vocabulary	Meaning
scan	an image obtained by scanning or with a scanner
opinion	a view or judgement formed about something, not necessarily based on fact or knowledge
comparison	the act of examining things to identify similarities or differences between them
paint tool	used to change the area of the canvas or image by adding paint strokes or filling the areas with colour
text tool	allows text to be typed into a document using different fonts or colours
create	bring (something) into existence
script	the written text of a play, film or broadcast
edit	change (text) on the computer
font	a set of type of one particular face and size
video camera	a camera for recording images on a videotape or for transmitting them to a monitor screen
online	while connected to a computer or under computer control
select	to choose from a variety of options
editable	(of text or software) in a format that can be edited by the user
review	assess (something) formally with the intention of instituting change if necessary


### Key knowledge

**Record** – produce (a programme, or a piece or collection of music) recording a performance

**Pause** – a temporary stop in action or speech


**Play** – to start a video in order to view a recording

**QR code** – a machine-readable code consisting of an array of black and white squares.
